




#### **Wyoming Agriculture is BIG Business**



In 2017, agriculture added \$1.77 billion to Wyoming's economy.



Wyoming's farms and ranches are the largest in the nation, averaging 2,649 acres.



Hay is the #1 crop in Wyoming, with over 25,000 tons harvested in 2017.



Cattle and calves are the most commonly raised livestock in Wyoming.



Wyoming ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the nation for production of barley. In 2017, Wyoming farmers raised 6,426 bushels of barley.



Wyoming ranks 4th in the nation for production of sheep and lambs.
