Students are encouraged to draw a bookmark that explains or promotes the stewardship of Wyoming's resources in one or multiple areas of: agriculture, minerals and energy, and/or outdoor recreation and tourism.

### By submitting your students' bookmarks the following is agreed upon

- Original artwork will not be sent back to students. If you want a copy of the artwork, please make sure to have a copy made prior to mailing the student's submission.
- Any and all artwork may be published on the website or in print for Wyoming Agriculture in the Classroom programs and promotion.

### Important Dates:

Entries must be postmarked by **January 31, 2020**  
Online voting will be open **March 16-27, 2020**  
Winners will be announced **April 6, 2020**

### Rules:

- Contest is open to all Wyoming 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students.
- Entries must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2020, to be eligible for the contest.
- Only one entry per student and the bookmark must be submitted on the designated entry form template found on Wyoming Agriculture in the Classroom (WAIC) website: [www.wyaitc.org](http://www.wyaitc.org).
- Drawing must stay within the template lines to avoid being trimmed.
- Entries should be submitted on a landscape 8 ½" x 11" heavyweight/card stock paper.
- Bookmark submission must address Stewardship of Wyoming's Resources.
- Contact information must be complete and clearly printed on the entry form. This information is utilized to send out information to all participants and finalists. WAIC staff will call if information is incomplete.
- Bookmark must be student's original artwork and message created within the 2019-20 school calendar year.
- DO NOT use metallic pens, crayons or markers for artwork submissions. Colored pencils are preferred.
- DO NOT sign the artwork. Student's name should not appear anywhere on the front side of the bookmark template.

### DEVELOP:

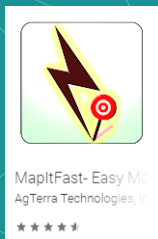
- A class map using MapItFast software, generously donated by AgTerra
